## Setup & Audio Routing

- We use an IEM system with a Behringer X32 Rack Mixer. **Please ensure that all stage wedges are turned off during our performance.**
- Guitars, bass, vocals, and drums require XLR connections.
- All non-drum signals (except the trigger) are routed through our ART S8-3-Way Splitter.
- Typically, instruments are connected to a splitter, which then routes the signals via a multicore cable to the venue's XLR switchboard.
- If space is limited and the rack cannot be used, we may bring a Behringer UMC1820 sound card instead.
  - Samples will be sent out via Main Stereo Outputs 1-2.
  - Click track will be sent via Output 3 (only to our IEM system).

Samples Left	SAMPLE L
Samples Right	SAMPLE R

We provide a 10m multicore 8-track XLR cable for connection to the venue mixer.

For pedalboards and microphones, we require at least 5 additional XLR cables:

- Guitar: 2x XLR
- Vocals: 2x XLR
- Bass: 1x XLR
